Nex-Tech, Inc. ("Nex-Tech") permits _____

1. The borrower acknowledges that the driver of the Nex-Tech Express must be at least 18 years of age and possess a valid driver's license.
2. The borrower agrees to report any accident, malfunction, damage or breakdown of the Nex-Tech Express to Nex-Tech, and further acknowledges that continued use of the Nex Tech Express following such accident, malfunction, damage or breakdown shall be at the borrower's sole risk and liability.
3. The borrower acknowledges that he/she has been properly trained on the setup and use of the Nex-Tech Express, and any questions pertaining to such were adequately answered by Nex-Tech before borrower assumed possession.
4. The borrower agrees not to use, or permit the use of, the Nex-Tech Express:
 - a. for any unlawful purpose
 - b. in a careless or negligent manner; and
 - c. without appropriate adult supervision to ensure safety
5. The borrower agrees to use the Nex-Tech Express only for the purposes provided herein.
6. Nex-Tech shall not be held liable for damages, inconvenience or time lost caused by accident, breakdown or malfunction of the Nex-Tech Express. The borrower agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Nex-Tech and its owners, agents, affiliates, managers, successors, assigns and personnel (collectively referred to as "affiliates") from and against any and all claims for loss of or damage to property or injury to person(s), including death, resulting through the use, operation or possession of the Nex-Tech Express.

This Agreement represents the entire understanding and agreement between Nex-Tech and the borrower with the regard to the subject matter hereof.

We have read this Agreement, fully understand the terms and conditions set forth herein, and warrant that we are authorized to execute this Agreement on behalf of the parties hereto.

Nex-Tech Express Procedures

Please follow these procedures to ensure proper handling:

Review, sign, and return the Nex-Tech Express Agreement Form.

The Nex-Tech Express will be transported to and from your event via trailer by a Nex-Tech Representative. You are responsible for making these arrangements and communicating the specific location that you would like the train and trailer placed when you return the agreement form.

The Nex-Tech Express is a converted lawn mower. It will be full of fuel upon arrival; you do not need to refill. However, if you would run out, you may fill with regular unleaded gasoline. The tank is located under the seat.

The Nex-Tech Express does require a key to run. You are, again, responsible for making arrangements to pick up the key when you return the agreement form. Contact information is displayed on the next page of this document.

To remove the train from the trailer:

1. Slide the pins out of place located by the trailer jack.
2. Jack up the trailer by utilizing the jack handle (bar) installed next to the hitch. Insert the bar into the jack and raise it up and down. The trailer will begin to tilt.
3. Once the trailer is at the desired height, you may remove the pins from the rear bar to remove the carts. The carts must be removed prior to removal of the mower.
4. To remove the mower, first unhook the wench from the front. You may then need to reverse the mower a small amount to unhook the chain from the back.
5. Start the mower using the key (if you have any difficulty starting the mower, check the seat—a safety feature requires a certain amount of weight on the seat.)
6. You should now be able to remove the mower from the trailer. Make sure to release the parking break.
7. After removing from the trailer, hook the train carts behind the mower in the order of which they are numbered. Note: Cart #1 must go in the front because it extends an additional length from the mower to allow for turning.
8. To bring the trailer back to level, turn the jack handle counter-clockwise. The trailer should then lower back into place. Remove the jack handle and place it back in its storage area.

To place the train back on the trailer:

1. If you lowered the trailer back down, jack it back up so that it tilts.
2. Detach each cart from the mower, including Cart #1.
3. Drive the mower onto the trailer. Set the parking break. Utilize the wench and the chain to secure the mower into place.
4. Using the pins that were removed earlier, hook the train carts back to the train on the trailer. Ensure they are in the correct order. If not, they may not fit properly.
5. Put the rear bar into place utilizing the pins.
6. Lower the trailer back to level by turning the jack handle counter-clockwise. Remove the jack handle and return it to its storage area. Move the pins back into place.

Troubleshooting

If you experience any difficulties starting the lawn mower, check the seat. The mower's safety feature requires a certain amount of weight on the seat before it will run.

If you experience a flat tire and an air compressor is not available, you may utilize the spare tire attached to the inside of the trailer.
