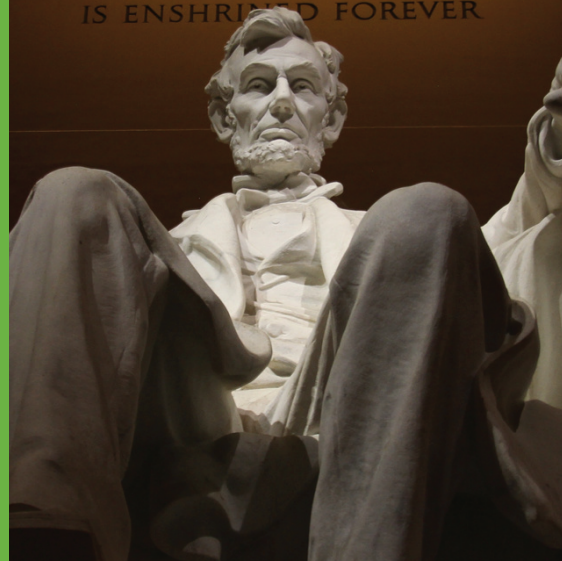

This unique educational experience provides an opportunity to visit Washington, DC, meet high school students from other states, and tour historical sites while also learning about Capitol Hill and the Federal government.

While on the Youth Tour, students will:

- Tour famous historical sites and monuments, including Arlington National Cemetery, Mt. Vernon, Lincoln Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial, and World War II Memorial
- Visit Smithsonian Museums
- Meet with Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and Congressional staff
- Attend a show at the Kennedy Center
- Build relationships with peers that can last a lifetime
- Develop leadership skills
