Once your user account is created by Nex-Tech, the Cloud Fax service will send you an automated email with your username and a temporary password. You will be required to change your temporary password upon your first login. A sample email is shown below. To ensure you receive this information, please make sure your spam filter is set to allow all messages from @nex-tech.com.





Sending Faxes with Web Client






Retrieving Faxes via Cloud Fax Web Client (Email delivery is setup automatically)






Cloud Fax Client Installation

1) Download CloudFax Client by logging into https://cloudfax.nex-tech.com/fax


















1) Open SendFax > Go to Start Menu > XMediusFax Folder > Send Fax
