## **LIFELINE //**

Lifeline is an FCC program that helps make telecommunications services more affordable for low-income consumers. Lifeline provides qualifying subscribers with a discount on monthly voice and Internet service.

### **How it works**

Lifeline assistance provides up to a \$13.02 monthly discount on voice service and up to \$9.25 monthly service on Internet, or a combined maximum discount for voice and Internet of \$17.02 per month.

### **Do you qualify?**

A consumer may be eligible if they meet one of the following criteria:

- ✓ *Participates in certain assistance programs, such as SSI, Medicaid, SNAP, FPHA, or has a Veteran's Pension Benefit.*
- ✓ *Household income is at or below 135% of the federal poverty level. To determine if you qualify based on income and location, visit [checklifeline.org](https://checklifeline.org) for additional information and for the application process.*

## **AFFORDABLE CONNECTIVITY PROGRAM (ACP) //**

The Affordable Connectivity Program is an FCC benefit program that helps ensure that households can afford the broadband they need for work, school, healthcare, and more.

### **How it Works**

The ACP benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward Internet service for eligible households. Qualifying households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer or tablet from participating providers.

### **Do You Qualify?**

A household is eligible for the Affordable Connectivity Program if the household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, or if a member of the household meets at least one of the criteria below:

- ✓ *Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;*
- ✓ *Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income Internet program;*
- ✓ *Participates in one of these assistance programs:  
Free and Reduced-Price School Lunch Program, SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Housing Assistance, Supplemental Security Income (SSI), WIC, Veterans Pension, Survivor Benefits, or Lifeline.*
